





This sloping glass façade once housed a live tree growing through an opening in the second floor, but is now home to the bank's corporate boardroom. The unprotected glass created a stunningly day-lit but unbearably hot space; essentially a green house.

Indoor Sky was asked to develop a solution that would allow control of both the temperature and daylight within the boardroom.

The solution features (54) fabric lightshelves motorized in groups of (6) as well as several conventional shades below. Each horizontal row of lightshelves is operable so that board members may select an appropriate amount of daylight and shade. The facade is capped off by a fixed canopy at the apex, adding an exquisite finishing touch!
